The purpose of said hearings is:

To receive public comment on the adoption of an update to the Shoreline Master Program (SMP); this proposed REVISED draft was completed by the Real Property Rights Advisory Board.

The purpose of this update is to bring the county's SMP in compliance with required changes under RCW Chapter 90.58 and WAC Chapter 173-26. The updated SMP will replace the existing program, last updated in 1980, including goals, policies, regulations, development standards and administrative procedures.


