SCHEDULE 1-A

SENIOR OR DISABLED CITIZEN DISCOUNT PROGRAM

INCOME ELIGIBILITY

Availability:

Current residential customers of the District who qualify and apply for a discount by filing an application attesting and affirming to the following:

1. Are at least 62 years of age or older or are a disabled citizen fulfilling criteria as established herein; and
2. Meet the income criteria as established herein; and
3. Applicants must be active residential accountholders and may not receive a discount for vacated homes, second homes, shops or outbuildings.

Discount Rate:

The discount of electric service billings for qualifying participants will be as shown below and apply only to the energy consumption portion of the residential rate schedule:

<u>Minimum Household Income</u>	<u>Maximum Household Income</u>	<u>Percentage Discount</u>
\$ 0	\$ 17,506	25%
\$ 17,507	\$ 21,750	20%
\$ 21,751	\$ 26,160	15%

General Provisions:

The District shall prepare application forms containing the above and such other affirmations as will carry out the purposes RCW 74.38.070.

The applicant approved for the discount program will be entitled to receive a discount for each billing period during a calendar year. An individual may apply for and begin the discount program at any time during the calendar year. Applicants must re-apply and qualify each calendar year. The discount will not be applied retroactively.

QUALIFYING INCOME:

Current monthly gross income will be considered. Income is the total gross income of all people living at the residence.

Disabled Citizen:

1. A person qualifying for special parking privileges under RCW 46.16.381 (1) (a) through (f);
 - a. Loss of both lower limbs; or
 - b. Loss of normal or full use of the lower limbs to sufficiently constitute a severe disability;
 - c. Is so severely disabled that the person cannot move without the aid of crutches or a wheelchair; or
 - d. Loss of both hands; or
 - e. Suffers from lung disease to such an extent that the forced expiratory respiratory volume, when measured by spirometry, is less than one liter per second; or
 - f. Impairment by cardiovascular disease to the extent that the person's functional limitations are classified as Class III or Class IV under standards accepted by the American Heart Association;

OR

2. A blind person as defined by RCW 74.18.020 (4):
 - a. "Blind" means a person who has no vision or whose vision with corrective lenses is so defective as to prevent the performance of ordinary activities for which eyesight is essential, or who has an eye condition of a progressive nature which may lead to blindness;

OR

3. A developmentally disabled person as defined in RCW 71A.10.020 (2):
 - a. "Developmental disability" means a disability attributable to mental retardation, cerebral palsy, epilepsy, autism, or another neurological or other condition of an individual found by the secretary to be closely related to mental retardation or to require treatment similar to that required for individuals with mental retardation, which disability originates before the individual attains age eighteen, which has continued or can be expected to continue indefinitely, and which constitutes a substantial handicap to the individual.
