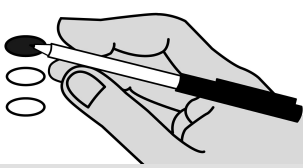

How to vote

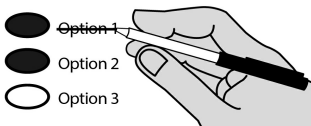


Use a blue or black ink pen.
