Understanding Recent Proposed Federal Legislation Related to Elections and Government Operations

Your local elections office is committed to providing clear, accurate, and nonpartisan information to voters. Below is a simple explanation of three proposed federal bills that have received public attention.

SAVE Act

Safeguard American Voter Eligibility Act

What it proposes:

- Would require individuals to provide **proof of U.S. citizenship** (such as a passport or birth certificate) when registering to vote in federal elections.

What this could mean:

- Additional documentation may be required to register to vote.
- Some eligible voters may need to take extra steps to complete registration.

SAVE America Act

Election Reform Proposal

What it proposes:

- A broader set of changes to election processes, which may include:
 - Voter identification requirements
 - Changes to mail-in voting rules
 - Updates to voter registration list maintenance
 - Additional election security measures

What this could mean:

- Possible changes to how elections are conducted
- Potential impacts to voting methods such as voting by mail or in person

MEGA Act

Government Operations Proposal

What it proposes:

- Focuses on improving government efficiency and reducing waste

What this could mean:

- Does **not directly affect voting or election procedures**
- Primarily impacts how government agencies operate

Important Information for Voters

- These items are **proposed legislation** and may or may not become law.
- Changes to election laws only take effect after being passed and implemented.
- Current voting processes remain unchanged unless officially updated.
